Important Information For Licence Holders

1. Your Certification Body is required to share auditing information with the PSA. Where major non-conformities are reported the PSA may suspend or revoke a licence. Certification to the relevant standard must be maintained at all times.

2. You must within 7 days notify the PSA in writing if any of the following occur:
- Change of name of the licence holder.
 - In the case of a body corporate, change in company directors.
 - In the case of a partnership, change in partners.
 - In the case of private investigators, change in operators.
 - Change of ownership of the business. In the case of a body corporate, this includes a change in any share holding above 5%.
 - Change of address from which the security service is being provided.
 - Change of registered address if this is different from address on licence.
 - Change in the legal status of the licence holder

Failure to notify us as required may result in your licence being suspended or revoked or your renewal application being refused.

3. You must within 7 days notify the PSA of any conviction against the licence holder whether in relation to the business of the licence holder or other matter. In the case of a body corporate this includes any convictions against a company director. In the case of a partnership this includes any convictions against a partner.

Failure to notify us as required may result in your licence being suspended or revoked or your renewal application being refused.

4. If you cease trading or cease to provide a licensable security service you must notify the PSA and return your original licence to us for cancellation.
